



TASK ORDER FORM NO. 5 GIS SERVICES

This Task Order is entered into on the effective date noted above pursuant to the "Professional Engineering Services" between the CITY OF SIMONTON ("City") and LJA ENGINEERING, INC. ("Engineer"), effective date April 1, 2021 ("Agreement"). The Agreement is incorporated herein and forms an integral part of this Task Order. However, in case of conflict, the terms of the Agreement shall control.

Scope of Services

Data Deployment - \$5,000 Time and Material

The City will provide available City assets and boundaries in a GIS format. In addition, the City may provide documents to be associated with the GIS data. Example) Annexation documents for annexed areas.

LJA anticipates at a minimum City Limits and City ETJs to be made available in either a GIS or CAD format.

In addition to the GIS Data provided by the City within this project, LJA will provide common base map information identified as aerial photography, appraisal district data, and streets and include CADs, MUDs and other special districts that are available.

GIS Web Site - \$5,000 Lump Sum plus \$100 a month Lump Sum for Hosting Services

LJA will provide a web (browser based) site with City and public access to view the GIS Data provided and referenced above.

The site will include navigation, measurement tools, layer controls and identification tools to interact with such data.

LJA will bill \$5,000 on a Lump Sum (LS) basis in addition to a \$100 a month fee for hosting services.

Pricing

Compensation for GIS Services described above will be based on a combined Lump Sum (LS) and Time and Material (T&M) basis.

The City will be billed up to \$5,000 for the Data Deployment phase (T&M).

The City will be billed \$5,000 for the GIS (LS Website plus \$100 per month for hosting).

If applicable to the work performed, for Texas state and local tax purposes, the GIS Services provided by LJA shall be considered to be taxable data processing services as defined under applicable law, Texas Administrative Code Rule §3.330. Texas state and applicable local sales tax will be charged on 80% of the monthly bill for the GIS services; 20% of the total amount charged for data processing services is exempted from tax.


