Summary of Assignment

The City of Simonton, Texas, is a small community of approximately 700 people situated in Fort Bend County on Texas FM 1093. The community is located on the western edge of the Houston Metropolitan area. The City has both a Type A and Type B Economic Development Corporation. The corporations were created in 2009. The corporations had annual reported revenues in 2020 of \$31,516 and \$63,032 with fund balances of \$126,308 and \$210,367 respectively.

The City's economic development efforts are limited as the vast majority of undeveloped land within the City's jurisdiction is part of a single development called Twinwood. The City has a development agreement with Twinwood which anticipates the respective roles of the entities. Though the ultimate development of Twinwood's various phases will result in tremendous growth for the city it is also impacts the nature, scope and approach of the City's economic development efforts.

The city has limited personnel and has previously contracted out for economic development services. Given the limited personnel resources, the City Administrator is seeking contract resources to support her efforts in the administration of the City's economic development program.

To this end, the City Administrator has identified the following key initial tasks

- 1. Program assessment.
- 2. Board education including:
 - Role of economic development in a community.
 - Review and discussion of role, purpose, powers and limitations of economic development corporations as well as the role of board members.
- 3. Staff support and administration of the city's Type A and Type B Corporations including creating board agendas, meeting support, and minutes
- 4. Resource and support for City Administrator for economic development program matters.
- Development of economic development corporation and program policy and process recommendations for City Administrator consideration and possible board action.
